Bro. Thomas M. Baker was born in Camden County, Georgia on June 28, 1941, to the late Robert and Tannah Baker, Sr. He was a member of Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church in Kingsland, Georgia, where he joined at an early age. He was educated in the public school system of Camden County and became a prominent citizen serving on various levels in the community. His formal education includes, a Bachelors Degree from Tuskegee University and a Masters Degree in English Literature from FAMU. He was a member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity.

Thomas also served as a former president of the local NAACP and was responsible for helping to establish the local chapter of the SCLC (Southern Christian Leadership Conference) for Camden County, served as a Deputy Sheriff of Camden County Police Force, he was employed by the Camden County Public School System as a Educator and was employed as a Professor at Edward Waters College in the Arts and Science Department at the time of his passing. Bro. Thomas was also a member of the Mighty Jubilairs Singers of Brunswick, Georgia.

On Monday, February 6, 2006, he departed this life at Memorial Hospital in Jacksonville, Florida following a brief illness. Two sisters preceded him in death, Virginia White and Maxine Creighton.

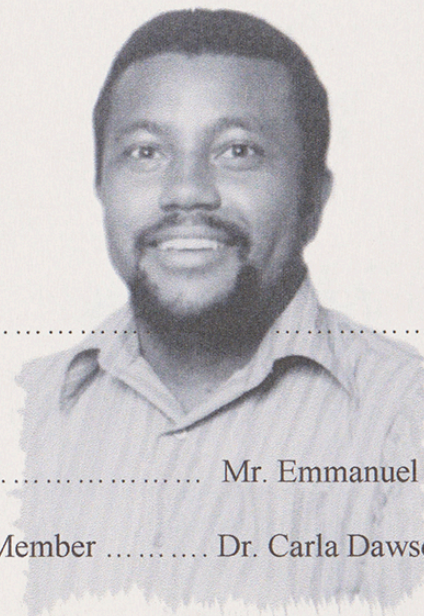
