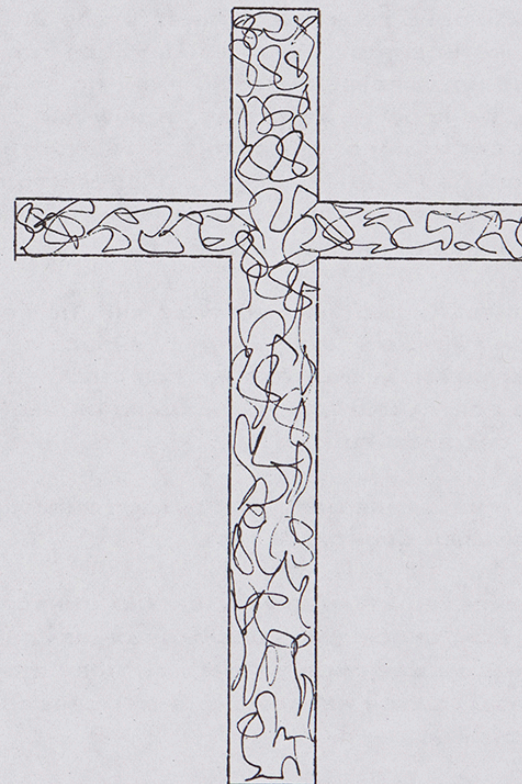

## OBITUARY
