Obituary

Rev. Walter Brown Baker was born July 4th, 1910 in Gross, Florida to the late Rev. Steve Baker, Sr. and Mrs. Maggie Baker.

He recieved his education in the Nassau County public schools.

He was united in marriage to Cora Mae Holzendorf June 19, 1937. This union was blessed with four children. The family resided in Gross, Florida until 1946. In 1946 residency was established in Kingland, Georgia at the present home place 560 Old Jefferson Road.

Rev. Baker being a faithful and loyal member of Mt. Carmel Baptist Church, Gross, Florida, under the leadership of Rev. Steve Baker, Sr. was converted on May 23, 1965. He received his license to preach the Gospel at Mt. Carmel Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Amos Fraizer. He served as Mt. Carmel Baptist Missionary Associate Minister until his ordination October 23, 1966.

His pastoral duties included St. James Baptist Church, Sandhill, Florida for sixteen years, St. Johns Baptist Church, Adris, Georgia for seventeen years and his duties also as Associate Pastor at New Mt. Carmel Baptist Church, Gross, Florida.

For more than thirty-two years he was employed by ITT Rayonier, Inc. before retiring August 1, 1972.

Upon his passing on November 7, 1993 at the Gilman Hospital, St. Marys, Georgia, Rev. Walter Baker leaves, to cherish his memories, a loving wife of fifty-six years Sister Cora Mae Baker, their three children, Bessie M. Baker, Louvenia Simmon and Tony T. Baker.
