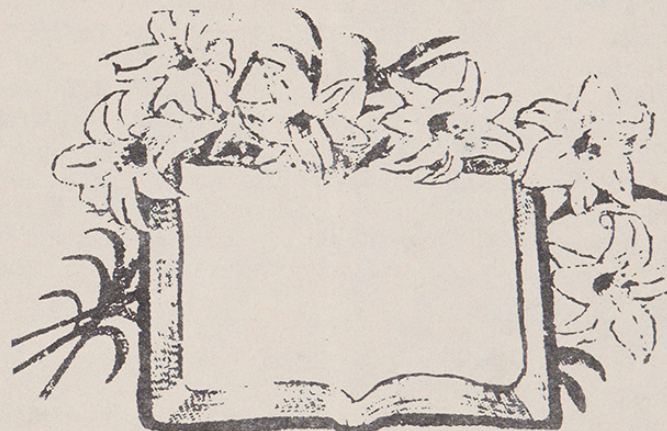

Obituary

On the morning of June 12, 1988, the angel of silence came into the room of Deacon Cecil Bullard, and with chilly fingers, sealed the lips of a christian, loving father, grandfather and great great grandfather. His soul winged its flight from this world of sin, sorrow and pain to a place of eternal rest.

Deacon Cecil "Doll" Bullard was the son of the late Edmond and Karie Bullard. He was one of 11 children, born on February 15, 1900. He was a native of Sylvania, Georgia and later moved to Camden County. He became a christian at an early age and joined St. James Church of God in Unity. In 1927, he was joined in holy matrimony to the late Daisy Wesly. To this union 12 children were born. Four of which preceeded him in death; Jessie, Willie Mae, Celia and William. In 1975 he moved to Jacksonville, Florida where he resided with his daughter Eloise and joined the Church of God in Christ with Reverend R. Dixon as pastor. There are some lives that disappoint us, some impressions of character which we have to revise in later years, but the impression that was formed of Deacon Bullard when you first met him remained unchanged to the end of his life.
