

But hopefully during my years I made memories that last.


Even though my life is over, there's no reason to grieve,



He lived at all times in keeping with the high standards set for him by his Master Jesus Christ. He loved to sing praises unto God. His love for the gospel will always live in our church through the lives he taught in the Lord's Service.

Reverend Bennie James Andrews shared his life of service with the love of his life for fifty-two years, Missionary Cora Andrews. To cherish his life and be comforted by many memories along with his wife; Sons: James (Mary) Campbell, Kingsland, GA; Robert (Jeanette) Dawson of Jacksonville, FL; and Bennie J. Church of God **OUR STATEMENTS** Declaration of Faith

We believe:

1. In the verbal inspiration of the Bible.
2. In one God eternally existing in three persons; namely, the Father, Son and Holy Ghost.
3. That Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of the Father, conceived of the Holy Ghost and born of the Virgin Mary. That Jesus was crucified, buried and raised from the dead. That He ascended to heaven and is today at the right hand of the Father as the Intercessor.
4. That all have sinned and come short of the glory of God and the repentance is commanded of God for all and necessary for forgiveness of sins.
5. That justification, regeneration and the new birth are wrought by faith in the blood of Jesus Christ.
6. In sanctification subsequent to the new birth, through faith in the blood of Christ; through the Word and by the Holy Ghost.
7. Holiness to be God's standard of living for His people.
8. In the baptism with the Holy Ghost subsequent to a clean heart.
9. In speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance and that it is the initial evidence of the baptism in the Holy Ghost.
10. In water baptism by immersion, and all who repent should be baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost.
11. Divine healing is provided for all in the Atonement.
12. In the Lord's Supper and washing of the saints' feet.
13. In the premillennial second coming of Jesus. First, to resurrect the righteous dead and to catch away the living saints to Him in the air. Second, to reign on the earth a thousand years.
14. In the bodily resurrection; eternal life for the righteous and eternal punishment for the wicked.
